## The need

1 in 3 women will have a termination in their lifetime, and 1 in 4 early pregnancies end in miscarriage. Around 1 in 240 pregnancies end in stillbirth. This is why Reflect exists to help those in need.

Approximately 97\% of terminations in recent years were carried out to reduce the risk of harm to the physical or mental health of the pregnant woman. However, we are continuing to see women and men for post-termination support.

Research shows a woman is best able to cope with a pregnancy choice decision made free from pressure or fear. A woman (and her partner) are far more likely to cope with a decision that has not been rushed, knowing they have made a truly informed choice, even if it is difficult at the time. We offer this time and space at Reflect.

In order to fulfil this vision and to continue to expand the work we do, we are asking you to help by giving financially.

To see anyone in North Yorkshire, enabled to make an informed decision about a pregnancy choice, without fear, pressure or judgment, and to support those who have been affected by pregnancy loss through miscarriage, stillbirth or post-termination.

## Pregnancy Choice

An unintended pregnancy can be a crisis for anyone whatever their circumstance. Or a planned pregnancy may turn into an agonising situation if a woman has been advised of a possible foetal anomaly after antenatal screening or diagnostic test. Facing this can be a difficult and confusing experience.

Our trained advisors help people work through all their options, enabling them to make a choice for themselves. We listen and provide space to help them think. We signpost to all appropriate services and relevant agencies for ongoing support.

## Pregnancy Loss

Miscarriage \& stillbirth affect many women and their difficult experience is not always acknowledged. We help women \& men to work through their emotions and grief.

After having an termination a woman may experience a variety of emotions, some may be unsettling and some may not surface until months or even years later.

We offer 'Reflections: Walking through loss'- A structured support programme for anyone struggling. This has proved to be life-changing for many women who have completed the programme at Reflect.
